Project:

This workcamp is realized with the cooperation of Ösvény Alapítvány (Path Foundation – www.uphill.hu), an organisation, that is dealing with ecological matters...

Work:

The main idea is to build an earth-house, during which work the volunteers will have a chance to do stamped wall, to throw adobe, to do masonry, wall carving, to plaster, etc. The work will mostly be physical, hard work, so we kindly ask volunteers to be aware of that when they apply!

Location:

Gyűrűfű is located in the south-west of Hungary, is a small Eco-village with a rich number of various animals and plants. The town already took part in ecological programmes and is well known in this sense over Hungary.

Accommodation:

The volunteers will sleep in a stone-build house or tents that belongs to the project partner.

Volunteers will cook together with the local volunteers and the local people in the village in the kitchen that is in the house where the volunteers will sleep.

Participation fee:

There is a fee of 60 Euros to participate in this project.

VP-02 HORÁNY

Project:

These workcamps are realized with the cooperation of the Forest School Foundation (FSF) in Szentendre. (www.kokosz.hu/eia)

Because Szentendre Island is an environmentally protected area, the public traffic is very rare to find. The atmosphere is very peaceful, it is more likely to hear birds singing than cars riding.

We truly believe that working in nature has a positive outcome towards people to be more open-minded, tolerant and that they do not judge each other by any national, regional or cultural differences, they respect each as persons.

Work:

The main work will be gardening, cutting wood, cleaning up the environment from possible garbage, taking part and/or making workshops on environmental topics (this happens with the cooperation of the Forest Education Foundation, our project partner), excursions in the area (by the Danube mainly), cycling etc.

Volunteers work 5 hours per day (weekends excluded). All volunteers must participate in the realisation of the everyday life, the preparation of food, cleaning the dishes, cleaning the house, etc.

Location:

Szigetmonostor-Horány, on the Szentendre Island, by the shore to Dunakeszi

It is only 40 kms away from Budapest. FSF has its camping site placed in Horány, almost inside of the forests, but very close to the Danube.

Accommodation:

In the youth camp of FSF that can host up to 125 people. The volunteers will stay in wooden houses, with 4-8 beds. Bathroom and toilet facilities available in a separated big hall.

Volunteers will make themselves breakfast and dinner in a well-equipped kitchen in the camp-site, lunch will be served in a beach-restaurant very close to the camp.

Short time EVS:

As we want to give a chance to everybody to take part in a voluntary project, we try to accept also those volunteers who have less opportunities to take part in a short time EVS.

Participation fee:

There is a fee of 70 Euros to participate in this project.

VP-03 AKLI FARM

25th August – 8th September 2008

Number of volunteers:

Project:

The farm is currently under archeological reconstruction that is joined with an architecture-historical research. The aim is to work up an open air museum, that presents the lifestyles and farming in the last century.

Work:

The volunteers will work together with archeologists and architects in the research, but every day will also be cleaning up and taking care of the farm regularly.

Location:

Akli is a small village 4 km from Zirc, a beautiful old town in the north east of Hungary.

In Zirc there is the old Cistercian Abbey, that is a precious spectacle in Hungary.

Accommodation:

The volunteers will live on the grange of the former Cistercian Abbey. They will sleep in the second and third floor of the granary in the farm in beds.

There are toilets in the garden next to the granary and showers are in barrels heated up by the sun ☺

Food is prepared by the hosts three times a day. Volunteers get the chance to meet the famous Hungarian cuisine!

Participation fee:

There is a fee of 50 Euros to participate in this project.
